

GOODNIGHT DORM ROOM written by Sam Kaplan and Keith Reigert is a lighthearted romp of sound advice from high school graduation to the end of one's four years of college. The advice is sound and sensible. Sam and Keith talk about what it means to leave home and be on your own perhaps quite a distance from home and the feelings you'll go through when dealing with these issues. Other important issues are brought up and all are written in an easy to read poetry format. Emily Fromm's illustrations are colorful and fun to look at while reading the poetic prose. The poetry makes the advice easy to understand and fun to read. The poetry, however, could have been better in my humble opinion. It seems flat in some segments but overall Goodnight Dorm Room is a fun read with useful advice thrown in for good measure. The first year of college is difficult for sure.

Sam and Keith want to see you do your best though all 4 or 5 years of your college experience. Heed their advice; you won't regret it. This book could be a great graduation present for that college-bound boy or girl.

Cute play on "Goodnight Moon" for college freshmen about to live in dorms for the first time. Nostalgic and reminiscent, although the rhyming and scansion aren't as rhythmic as the original, this does bring up some important and serious topics (e.g. "dorm-cest" encourages one to carefully consider dating someone who resides in your dorm). Some sections may feel inappropriate to some.

This book is a whimsical set of sound advice for teens going off to college. The illustrations are colorful and silly, and the rhymes and humor make it less of a lecture and more of an ode to how to live in college.

I bought this book for my younger cousin as he prepares to head off to college, and I'm very glad I did so! I haven't gifted it yet, but just looking through it made me pine for my college days. The illustrations are whimsical and fun, and the light-hearted prose makes reading it a joy as well. Despite these friendly appearances, the book is packed with useful information and general college/life advice. The author strikes a nice balance between what needs to be done to succeed in college, and encouraging the young reader to enjoy themselves while living that college dream. The advice is really good, and the author doesn't get bogged down in absolutes, but instead gives reasonable and helpful general advice on how to have a good college experience. While some may disagree, I think it would have been comforting and delightful to have this jolly guide to help with surviving that period between the end of high school and the beginning of real life.
